and unique in every way.*

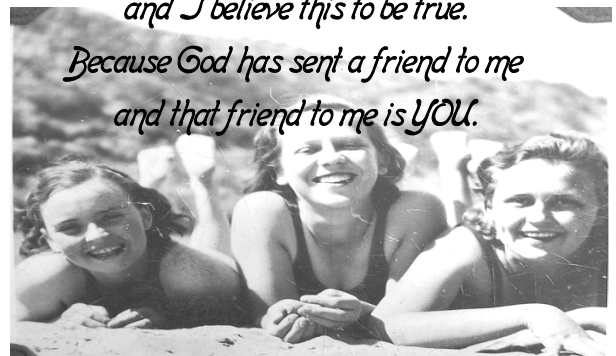
*And when you have problems a true friend
