I promise we'll only have fun.

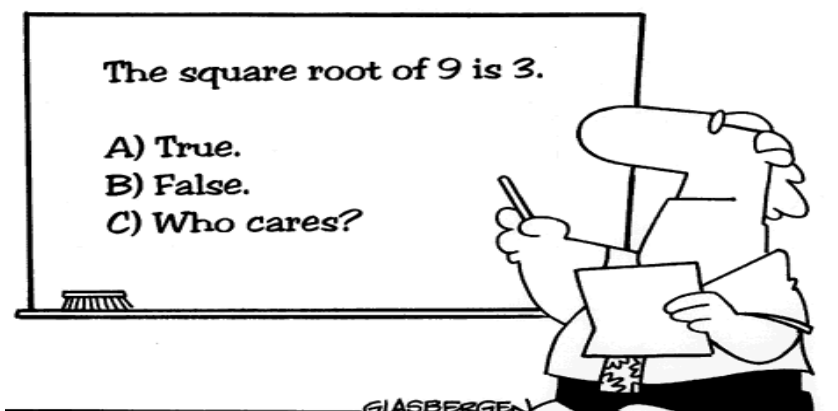
"We won't study any mathematics,
